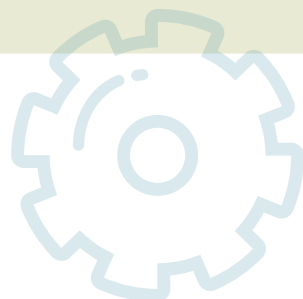

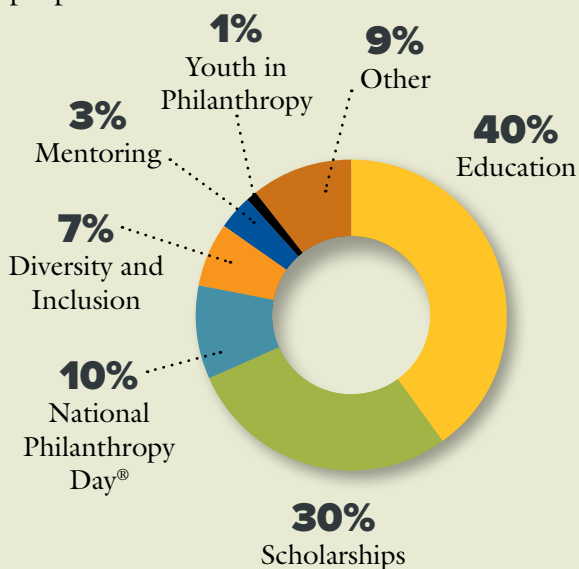




Chapter Partnership Grants

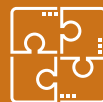

Through the AFP Leadership Academy, sponsored by the AFP Foundation for Philanthropy, relevant training is provided on leadership development for fundraising professionals, both to lead an AFP chapter, but more importantly to develop leadership skills for the nonprofit sector.
