RE: CFRE releases new Test Content Outline

The Test Content Outline is a comprehensive list of the Domains, Tasks and Knowledge areas that is based on the results of CFRE’s extensive research project.

The Test Content Outline identifies the percent and number of questions that are covered per subject area on the new CFRE Certification Examination, scheduled to launch in North America on 3 June 2011.

Candidates can review the Test Content Outline to assist them in identifying knowledge areas they are familiar with and those areas which may require some review.

The Certified Fund Raising Executive examination is designed as a practice-based examination for practitioners to assess mastery of the six core knowledge areas that are directly linked to the tasks of professional fundraisers. The exam covers fundamental, baseline knowledge versus any particular aspect of the fundraising process in depth.

Changes to the new Test Content Outline, and new CFRE examination do not impact current CFRE’s in their recertification process.
